

AMENDMENT NO. 47

**TO THE CHAIRMAN'S MARK FOR TITLE VII
OF THE ENERGY POLICY BILL**

Intended to be proposed by Mr. CAMPBELL

Purpose: To define lease condensate and fuels derived from lease condensate as alternative fuels under the Energy Policy Act of 1992.

Viz:

1 On page 144, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following:

2 **SEC. 708. LEASE CONDENSATE FUELS.**

3 Section 301 of the Energy Policy Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 13211) is further amended —

4 (a) in paragraph (2), by inserting “mixtures containing 50 percent or more by volume of
5 lease condensate or fuels extracted from lease condensate;” after “liquified petroleum gas;”;

6 (b) in paragraph (15), by inserting “mixtures containing 50 percent or more by volume
7 of lease condensate or fuels extracted from lease condensate;” after “liquified petroleum gas;”;

8 and

9 (c) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(16) the term ‘lease condensate’ means a mixture, primarily of pentanes and
11 heavier hydrocarbons, which is recovered as a liquid from natural gas in lease
12 separation facilities.”.
