1 On page 238, between lines 2 and 3, insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **Subtitle E—Measures to Conserve**
4 **Petroleum**

5 SEC. ____ REDUCTION OF DEPENDENCE ON IMPORTED PE-
6 TROLEUM.

7 (a) REPORT.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than February 1,
9 2004, and annually thereafter, the President shall

1 submit to Congress a report, based on the most re-
2 cent edition of the Annual Energy Outlook published
3 by the Energy Information Administration, assessing
4 the progress made by the United States toward the
5 goal of reducing dependence on imported petroleum
6 sources by 2013.

7 (2) CONTENTS.—The report under subsection
8 (a) shall—

9 (A) include a description of the implemen-
10 tation, during the previous fiscal year, of provi-
11 sions under this Act relating to domestic crude
12 petroleum production;

13 (B) assess the effectiveness of those provi-
14 sions in meeting the goal described in para-
15 graph (1); and

16 (C) describe the progress in developing and
17 implementing measures under subsection (b).

18 (b) MEASURES TO REDUCE IMPORT DEPENDENCE
19 THROUGH INCREASED DOMESTIC PETROLEUM CON-
20 SERVATION.—

21 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after
22 the date of enactment of this Act, the President
23 shall develop and implement measures to conserve
24 petroleum in end-uses throughout the economy of
25 the United States sufficient to reduce total demand

1 for petroleum in the United States by 1,000,000
2 barrels per day from the amount projected for cal-
3 endar year 2013 in the reference case contained in
4 the report of the Energy Information Administration
5 entitled "Annual Energy Outlook 2003".

6 (2) CONTENTS.—The measures under para-
7 graph (1) shall be designed to ensure continued reli-
8 able and affordable energy for consumers.

9 (3) IMPLEMENTATION.—The measures under
10 paragraph (1) shall be implemented under existing
11 authorities of appropriate Federal executive agencies
12 identified by the President.
