2 **SEC. 2. CONFIRMATION OF USE OF CERTAIN NON-FEDERAL**

3 **LAND IN SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH, FOR VALID**

4 **PUBLIC PURPOSES.**

5 (a) CONFIRMATION OF USES.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The use by the University of

7 Utah of the land described in subsection (b) as a

8 University research park, as approved by the letter

9 from the Secretary of the Interior to the University

10 of Utah dated December 10, 1970, and any modi-

11 fications of the approved plan of development and

1 management approved by the Department of the In-
2 terior prior to the date of enactment of this Act, is
3 confirmed as a valid public purpose consistent with
4 the requirements of the Act of June 14, 1926 (com-
5 monly known as the “Recreation and Public Pur-
6 poses Act”) (44 Stat. 741, chapter 578; 43 U.S.C.
7 869 et seq.), subject to the terms and conditions in-
8 cluded in the letter and approvals.

9 (2) OTHER USES.—Any other uses of the land
10 described in subsection (b) by the University of Utah
11 that are consistent with use as a University research
12 park and related university purposes (including de-
13 velopment of student housing and a transit hub) are
14 confirmed as valid public purposes consistent with
15 the requirements of the Act of June 14, 1926 (com-
16 monly known as the “Recreation and Public Pur-
17 poses Act”) (44 Stat. 741, chapter 578; 43 U.S.C.
18 869 et seq.), subject to the terms and conditions re-
19 ferred to in paragraph (1).

20 (b) DESCRIPTION OF NON-FEDERAL LAND.—The
21 land referred to in subsection (a) is the approximately
22 593.54 acres of land conveyed to the University of Utah
23 under the Act of June 14, 1926 (commonly known as the
24 “Recreation and Public Purposes Act”) (44 Stat. 741,
25 chapter 578; 43 U.S.C. 869 et seq.), by patent numbered

1 43-99-0012 and dated October 18, 1968, and more par-
2 ticularly described as tracts D (excluding parcels num-
3 bered 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5), G, and J, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., Salt
4 Lake Meridian.
