3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fire Island AIDS Me-
5 morial Establishment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURPOSES.**

7 The purposes of the Act are—

8 (1) to honor and remember the many residents
9 of Fire Island Pines and Cherry Grove, New York,
10 who suffered and died from the AIDS epidemic; and

11 (2) to educate future generations about the
12 AIDS epidemic and the impact of the AIDS epi-

1 demic on the Fire Island communities in the State
2 of New York.

3 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

4 In this Act:

5 (1) FOUNDATION.—The term “Foundation”
6 means the Pines Foundation, a tax-exempt organiza-
7 tion affiliated with the Fire Island Pines Property
8 Owners’ Association.

9 (2) MEMORIAL.—The term “Memorial” means
10 the Fire Island AIDS Memorial authorized to be es-
11 tablished under section 4(a).

12 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
13 the Secretary of the Interior.

14 **SEC. 4. FIRE ISLAND AIDS MEMORIAL.**

15 (a) AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.—
16 Subject to subsection (c) and any terms and conditions
17 the Secretary considers appropriate, the Foundation may
18 establish and maintain a memorial within the boundaries
19 of Fire Island National Seashore to honor the residents
20 of Fire Island who died of AIDS, to be known as the “Fire
21 Island AIDS Memorial”.

22 (b) USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS PROHIBITED.—Fed-
23 eral funds may not be used to design, procure, prepare,
24 install, or maintain the Memorial.

1 (c) DESIGN AND LOCATION OF MEMORIAL.—The de-
2 sign and location of the Memorial shall be subject to the
3 approval of the Secretary.
