9	(a) Grants.—	
10	(1) Authorization.—To the extent provided	
11	in advance in appropriations Acts and subject to	
12	paragraphs (2) and (3), the Secretary may provide	
13	to the Foundation grants in an amount not to ex-	
14	ceed a total of \$50,000,000 for the establishment of	
15	the Library—	
16	(A) to preserve and make available to the	
17	public materials relating to the life of President	
18	Theodore Roosevelt; and	
19	(B) to provide interpretive and educational	
20	services that communicate the meaning of the	
21	life of Theodore Roosevelt.	
22	(2) Matching requirement.—The Secretary	
23	may not provide a grant under paragraph (1) until	
24	the date on which the Foundation certifies to the	
25	Secretary that the Foundation has received an	

1	amount equal to not less than $$100,000,000$ from
2	funds for the Library—
3	(A) contributed by the State of North Da-
4	kota; or
5	(B) raised from non-Federal sources dur-
6	ing the period beginning on the date on which
7	the Foundation was established and ending on

9	(3) Prohibition on use of funds.—Grant
10	funds provided under this subsection may not be
11	used for the maintenance or operation of the Li-

13	(b) Federal Artifacts and Objects Relating
14	TO THEODORE ROOSEVELT.—Not later than 180 days
15	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary may
16	enter into 1 or more agreements with the Foundation to
17	provide for a loan to the Foundation from Federal agen-
18	cies under the administrative jurisdiction of the Secretary
19	(including the National Park Service and the United
20	States Fish and Wildlife Service) of historic, educational,
21	artistic, natural, and other museum artifacts and objects,
22	particularly artifacts and objects that are not on display
23	to the public, without monetary consideration, subject to
24	such terms and conditions as the Secretary determines to

1 be necessary for the preservation and exhibition of the ar-

- 2 tifacts and objects loaned to the Foundation.
- 3 (c) Non-Federal Operation.—The Secretary or
- 4 any other Federal entity shall have no involvement in the
- 5 operation of the Library, except at the request of the non-
- 6 Federal entity responsible for the operation of the Library
- 7 in accordance with applicable laws (including regulations).
