14	fiscal year thereafter, amounts deposited in the Fund
15	under section 200302 shall be made available for expendi-
16	ture, without further appropriation or fiscal year limita-
17	tion, to carry out the purposes of the Fund (including ac-
18	counts and programs made available from the Fund under
19	the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations
20	Act, 2015 (Public Law 113–235)).
21	"(b) Additional Amounts.—Amounts made avail-
22	able under subsection (a) shall be in addition to amounts
