1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Ending Presidential

5 Overreach on Public Lands Act".

6 SEC. 2. NATIONAL MONUMENTS.

7 Section 320301 of title 54, United States Code (com8 monly referred to as the "Antiquities Act"), is amended
9 to read as follows:

1 "§ 320301. National monuments

- 2 "The establishment or extension of a national monu-
- 3 ment may be undertaken only by express authorization of
- 4 Congress.".
