AN ACT

To expand the boundary of the San Antonio Missions
National Historical Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “San Antonio Missions
3 National Historical Park Boundary Expansion Act of
4 2013”.

5 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY EXPANSION.**

6 Section 201(a) of Public Law 95–629 (16 U.S.C.
7 410ee(a)) is amended—

8 (1) by striking “In order” and inserting “(1) In
9 order”;

10 (2) by striking “The park shall also” and in-
11 serting the following:

12 “(2) The park shall also”;

13 (3) by striking “After advising the” and insert-
14 ing the following:

15 “(5) After advising the”.

16 (4) by inserting after paragraph (2) (as so des-
17 ignated by paragraph (2)) the following:

18 “(3) The boundary of the park is further modified
19 to include approximately 137 acres, as depicted on the
20 map titled ‘San Antonio Missions National Historical
21 Park Proposed Boundary Addition’, numbered 472/
22 113,006A, and dated June 2012. The map shall be on
23 file and available for inspection in the appropriate offices
24 of the National Park Service, U.S. Department of the In-
25 terior.

1 “(4) The Secretary may not acquire by condemnation
2 any land or interest in land within the boundaries of the
3 park. The Secretary is authorized to acquire land and in-
4 terests in land that are within the boundaries of the park
5 pursuant to paragraph (3) by donation or exchange only
6 (and in the case of an exchange, no payment may be made
7 by the Secretary to any landowner). No private property
8 or non-Federal public property shall be included within the
9 boundaries of the park without the written consent of the
10 owner of such property. Nothing in this Act, the establish-
11 ment of the park, or the management plan of the park
12 shall be construed to create buffer zones outside of the
13 park. That an activity or use can be seen or heard from
14 within the park shall not preclude the conduct of that ac-
15 tivity or use outside the park.”.
