1 On page 159, after line 23, add the following:

2 **SEC. 211. ETHANOL CONTENT OF GASOLINE.**

3 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) CELLULOSIC BIOMASS ETHANOL.—The
5 term “cellulosic biomass ethanol” means ethanol de-
6 rived from any lignocellulosic or hemicellulosic mat-
7 ter that is available on a renewable or recurring
8 basis, including—

9 (A) dedicated energy crops and trees;

10 (B) wood and wood residues;

- 1 (C) plants;
- 2 (D) grasses;
- 3 (E) agricultural residues; and
- 4 (F) fibers.
- 5 (2) WASTE DERIVED ETHANOL.—The term
- 6 “waste derived ethanol” means ethanol derived
- 7 from—
- 8 (A) animal wastes, including poultry fats
- 9 and poultry wastes, and other waste materials;
- 10 or
- 11 (B) municipal solid waste.
- 12 (3) ETHANOL.—The term “ethanol” means cel-
- 13 lulosic biomass ethanol and waste derived ethanol.
- 14 (b) RENEWABLE FUEL PROGRAM.—Notwithstanding
- 15 any other provision of law, not later than 1 year after the
- 16 date of enactment of this section, the Secretary shall pro-
- 17 mulgate regulations ensuring that each gallon of gasoline
- 18 sold or dispensed to consumers in the contiguous United
- 19 States contains 10 percent ethanol by 2015.
