Chairman Murkowski & Ranking Member Cantwell Announce April Hearing Schedule

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee will hold five hearings in April, including oversight hearings on the Bureau of Land Management’s final hydraulic fracturing rule, the administration's Quadrennial Energy Review, the Energy Information Administration’s 2015 energy outlook, and the Land and Water Conservation Fund, as well as a legislative hearing on measures being considered for inclusion in the energy efficiency title of a broader energy bill.

Wednesday, April 22, 10 a.m. Full committee [hearing](#) to receive testimony on reauthorization of and potential reforms to the Land and Water Conservation Fund.
