S. 436, a bill to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to retire coal preference right lease applications for which the Secretary has made an affirmative commercial quantities determination, to substitute certain land selections of the Navajo Nation, to designate certain wilderness areas, and for other purposes. (Heinrich)
2. S. 440, a bill to establish a procedure for the conveyance of certain Federal property around the Dickinson Reservoir in the State of North Dakota. (Hoeven)
3. S. 612/H.R. 1547, a bill to provide for the unencumbering of title to non-Federal land owned by the city of Tucson, Arizona, for purposes of economic development by conveyance of the Federal reversionary interest to the City. (Flake/McSally)
4. S. 930, a bill to require the Administrator of the Western Area Power Administration to establish a pilot project to provide increased transparency for customers, and for other purposes. (Flake)
5. S. 966, a bill to establish a program to accurately document vehicles that were significant in the history of the United States, and for other purposes (Peters)
6. S. 1029, a bill to amend the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 to exempt certain small hydroelectric power projects that are applying for relicensing under the Federal Power Act from the licensing requirements of that Act. (King)
7. S. 1030, a bill to require the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to submit to Congress a report on certain hydropower projects. (King)
8. S. 1142, a bill to extend the deadline for commencement of construction of certain hydroelectric projects. (Cassidy)
9. S. 1219, a bill to provide for stability of title to certain land in the State of Louisiana, and for other purposes. (Cassidy)

10. S. 1403, a bill to amend the Public Lands Corps Act of 1993 to establish the 21st Century Conservation Service Corps to place youth and veterans in national service positions to conserve, restore, and enhance the great outdoors of the United States, and for other purposes. (McCain)
11. S. 1459, a bill to establish Fort Sumter and Fort Moultrie National Park in the State of South Carolina, and for other purposes. (Scott)
12. S. 1548, a bill to designate certain land administered by the Bureau of Land Management and the Forest Service in the State of Oregon as wilderness and national recreation areas and to make additional wild and scenic river designations in the State of Oregon, and for other purposes. (Wyden)
13. S. 1573, a bill to authorize the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to place signage on Federal land along the trail known as the “American Discovery Trail,” and for other purposes. (Coons)
14. S. 1645, a bill to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of P.S. 103 in West Baltimore, Maryland, and for other purposes. (Cardin)
15. S. 1646, a bill to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of President Station in Baltimore, Maryland, and for other purposes. (Cardin)
16. S. 2074, a bill to establish a procedure for the conveyance of certain Federal property around the Jamestown Reservoir in the State of North Dakota, and for other purposes. (Hoeven)
17. S. 2102/H.R. 4266, a bill to clarify the boundary of Acadia National Park, and for other purposes. (King/Poliquin)
18. S. 2218/H.R.4609, a bill to provide for the conveyance of a Forest Service site in Dolores County, Colorado, to be used for a fire station. (Bennet/Tipton)
19. S. 2238, a bill to amend the Ohio & Erie Canal National Heritage Canalway Act of 1996 to repeal the funding limitation. (Brown)
20. S. XXXX, a bill to designate a National Nordic Museum in Washington State. (Cantwell)

21. H.R. 497, a bill to direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain Federal lands in San Bernardino County, California, to the San Bernardino Valley Water Conservation District, and to accept in return certain exchanged non-Federal lands, and for other purposes. (Cook)
22. H.R. 965, a bill to redesignate the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site as the 'Saint-Gaudens National Historical Park', and for other purposes. (Kuster)
23. H.R. 995, a bill to direct the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior to modernize terms in certain regulations. (Jeffries)
24. H.R. 1900, a bill to designate the Veterans Memorial and Museum in Columbus, Ohio, as the National Veterans Memorial and Museum, and for other purposes. (Stivers)
25. H.R. 2582, a bill to authorize the State of Utah to select certain lands that are available for disposal under the Pony Express Resource Management Plan to be used for the support and benefit of State institutions, and for other purposes (Love)
26. H.R. 2768, a bill to designate certain mountain peaks in the State of Colorado as "Fowler Peak" and "Boskoff Peak." (Tipton)
27. H.R. 2786, a bill to amend the Federal Power Act with respect to the criteria and process to qualify as a qualifying conduit hydropower facility. (Hudson)
28. H.R. 2897, a bill to authorize the Mayor of the District of Columbia and the Director of the National Park Service to enter into cooperative management agreements for the operation, maintenance, and management of units of the National Park System in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes. (Norton)
