**WASHINGTON, D.C.** – The Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee today announced its next five upcoming hearings over the coming weeks on a variety of issues, including the fourth and final legislative hearing related to a broad energy bill; drought conditions throughout the western United States; the Nuclear Waste Administration Act of 2015; Department of Energy nominations; and legislation before the National Parks Subcommittee. - **Tuesday, June 2, 10 a.m.** Full committee [hearing](#) to receive testimony on the status of drought conditions throughout the western United States and actions states and others are taking to address them.
- **Tuesday, June 9, 9:30 a.m. REVISED and RESCHEDULED** Full committee [hearing](#) to receive testimony on energy accountability and reform legislation.
- **Wednesday, June 10, 2:30 p.m.** Subcommittee on National Parks legislative [hearing](#).
- **Tuesday, June 16, 10 a.m.** Full committee [hearing](#) to consider Department of Energy nominations.
- **Thursday, July 9, 10 a.m.** Full committee [hearing](#) to receive testimony on the back-end of the nuclear fuel cycle and related legislation, including [S. 854](#), the Nuclear Waste Administration Act of 2015.
